To Whom it May Concern:

Below is a summary of the progress made by Mountainville Academy on their academic plan for 2007-2008 for the School LAND Trust program. These funds facilitated tremendous improvement to our academic program, specifically in the area of technology.

1. \$13,996.10 was spent on 13 computers that combined with 13 donated computers, allowed for a fully stationed computer lab addition to the school. 400 students are now able to participate in keyboarding/typing one period per week and 150 students also participate in keyboarding/typing, web design and career instruction 2.5 periods per week. This has greatly enhanced our curriculum to include instruction on keyboarding and computer literacy.
2. \$100 was spent on 25 keyboarding textbooks
3. \$450 was spent on set up, repairs and maintenance for the computer lab
4. \$6300 was spent on a part-time computer lab assistant for 30 hours per week
5. \$1597.50 was spent on two overhead projectors. These are used frequently school-wide for instruction, teacher trainings and assemblies.
6. The balance of \$6,364.44 will be rolled over to the music (fine arts) program next year
